HURRICANE PREPARATION LIST

HOME ITEMS

- 1. Drinking Water – 1 Gallon, per person, per day**
- 2. Non-perishable food items**
- 3. Manual can opener**
- 4. Juice, instant coffee, tea bags**
- 5. Cooler, camping burner or stove**
- 6. Lighter/matches**
- 7. Flashlight**
- 8. Portable radio**
- 9. Extra batteries**
- 10. Hearing Aid Batteries**
- 11. First Aid Kit**
- 12. Portable Phone Charger (ie: Solar)**

MOVING TO A SHELTER OR HOTEL

- 1. Blankets, pillows, sleeping bag**
- 2. Medications**
- 3. Toiletries**
- 4. Glasses, hearing aids, CPAP machine**
- 5. Extra clothing, rain gear, shoes**
- 6. Important papers, insurance policies and Valid ID**
- 7. CASH, credit card, checks, paper and pens**
- 8. Spare Keys, snacks**

PETS/SERVICE ANIMALS

- 1. Water – 1 Gallon, per animal, per day**

2. Crate or carrier for each pet
3. Food, treats, comfort items
4. Clean up supplies
5. Immunization records

EVACUATIONS

*****THE CLUBHOUSE is not rated as a storm shelter, therefore WILL NOT be available for use as a shelter. PLEASE plan accordingly.**

Although Fountain View is located in Flood Zone D, ALL MANUFACTURED HOMES are required to evacuate when the first evacuations in LEE COUNTY are called for.

Before evacuating, please be sure to secure all items on your property that may become airborne during a storm. This includes putting up or lowering your storm shutters.

Keep informed and up to date on the upcoming storm activity via television, radio, and various Social Media Tools available to you. There are several available, including apps from the various news channels.
